Champion the social, health (emotional, physical, psychological wellness) and educational rights of the child burn survivor.

Establish a Helps and community centre offering the skills, education (in business and other areas), entrepreneurial opportunities, literacy programs and creative/performing arts workshops and facilitate transportation.
